



Summary Fees 2025-26

Registration Fee

If you would like to apply for a place at Brighton College, we ask for a non-refundable registration fee of £470 (incl VAT) for our overseas/international pupils.

Acceptance Deposit

Once offered, a place cannot be secured until the College is in receipt of the completed and signed Acceptance Form and cleared deposit.

A deposit is required on joining the College and a top-up element may be required if you switch between Day and Boarding Status.

¹ Pupils whose parents reside overseas or do not have settled status or who are not ordinarily resident in the UK.

Please note that one term's fees will be immediately payable if, for any reason, the acceptance of a place is cancelled by you less than one term (plus the holidays prior to that term) before entry or if the pupil does not join the College after a place has been accepted. If the required period of notice is not received then the higher of one term's fees or the Acceptance Deposit becomes due and immediately payable (if not already paid) and will be retained by the College.

Once accepted, deposits are retained and held over from term to term until the pupil leaves the most senior of the schools they attend. Any balance due will be refunded as a credit (without interest) against the final payment of extras or other sums due to the College. Please note, deposits are not a contribution towards the first, final or any term's tuition or boarding fees.

For pupils entering the Senior School, the deposit will only be refunded if a pupil does not meet the requirements set out within their offer letter.

Entrance Fee

A non-refundable charge of £120 (incl VAT) is made to cover the immediate administrative costs of entry into the College. This is added to the first term's fee.

Termly Tuition Fees - Overseas/International Pupils

Fees are due and payable before 8am on the first day of term. For full details please refer to the Standard Terms and Conditions. For details on what the Day and Boarding fees include, please refer to the Detailed Fees Structure document on our website.

All fees quoted above are inclusive of VAT and the 2025/26 transitional price support applied for payers whose tuition/boarding fees are subject to VAT. Price support is a fifth of the 20% VAT. Note that the lunch element included within the fee is not subject to VAT.

Please note that it is not always possible to change from a Full Boarding to a Weekly Boarding (or Day) place. Requests should be made with a minimum of two terms' notice to the Director of Boarding and the Director of Admissions. In some cases we may need to charge the relevant prior Boarding fee for the whole academic year if a mid-year switch is requested.

Additional Support Fees

There is a range of other support offered for pupils at the College, details of which can be found in our Detailed Fees Structure document. These include specialist learning support, English as an Additional Language (EAL), music, drama (LAMDA) and dance lessons and optional insurances.
