TIMELINE FOR SEPTEMBER 2024 ENTRY

Stage One: Enquiring

Making an enquiry is the first stage of the admissions process. At this point, the school will request a copy of your child's current school report. We encourage non-English native language speaking applicants to also submit a UKiset report. This helps both you and the College in determining whether Brighton College is the right choice.

Stage Two: Registering

After the Admissions Co-ordinator has received your child's school report(s) and confirmed that the school would like to progress the application, the Co-ordinator will email you an online registration form.

Registration will close at **5.00 pm GMT on Friday 1 September 2023.**

For candidates applying via the Academic Asia 'Hong Kong Top Schools' event, registration will close on **Sunday 1 October 2023.**

Stage Three: Assessments

Assessments will be held at a British Council office in the applicant's relevant city:

Hong Kong: Monday 11 September - Sunday 15 October 2023

Academic Asia 'Hong Kong Top Schools': Sunday 8 October 2023

All other countries: Monday 11 September - Sunday 15 October 2023

N.B. 11+ and 12+ assessments must be completed by the end of November.

Interviews are conducted either in person or via MS Teams.

As a 'Highly Trusted Sponsor' with the UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI), the school will sponsor a European Union (EU) or non-EU nationality pupil for their Child Student study visa.

Stage Four: Results

Results will be made available by the end of November 2023.
